## Top Takeaways

### **Set YOUR Fleet's Vision**

NREL will create an electrification plan specifically tailored to YOUR fleet; intended to reduce the burden of the electrification process whether it is experimental or mandated.

### **Six Months From The Kickoff Call**

All applicants will first receive a vetting call to ensure the electrification of YOUR fleet is realistic. After being accepted, NREL estimates YOUR fleet will have its own Electrification Transition Plan within 6 months of the kickoff call.

### **DATA and TIME**

NREL expects ALL applicants to provide their fleet data (route data, scheduling, etc) and attend monthly meetings with NREL and its partners to ensure a plan that works for YOUR fleet.

### **Grant Preparedness**

CBPA does **not** fund any deployment assistance but can help YOUR fleet stand out when applying for grants. CBPA directly *complements* the [EPA's Clean School Bus Program](#) and [FTA's Low-No program](#), both require varying degrees of pre-project planning

### **It is YOUR Choice for Contractors**

NREL will help you connect with 3rd party contractors OR choose to work with contractors YOUR fleet already has established relationships with.
